Affirm our inquiry-based curriculum, explore emerging pedagogies, support faculty, and create a culture of inclusion

Results:

SCDS has enhanced its academic program across all grades and subject areas, while remaining committed to an inquiry-based approach for gifted learners. Key program developments include:

- Implemented Social Emotional Learning (SEL) curriculum comprehensively across all grades
- Expanded curriculum to include debate, rhetoric, drama, and musical theater
- Expanded global/multicultural/diversity studies and learning experiences
- Enhanced grades 4-8 co-curricular trips to more closely tie to curriculum
- Improved high school application readiness for students and families
- Established faculty mentoring/professional development program

Results:

SCDS has engaged in concerted efforts to embrace and sustain relationships with our community. Our culture has been enriched by increased parent volunteerism, participation,

In the area of Positioning and Marketing Communications

- Expanded use of social media platforms for greater engagement

- Enhanced systems to improve retention of diverse students and families

- Developed and provided programs for parent education
